



Road Safety Short Film Competition 2017

OVERVIEW

The Road Safety Short Film Competition has been developed in partnership with Barunga Festival, Skinnyfish Music and the Northern Territory Government.

The objective of the Film Competition is to promote responsible road user behaviour and raise awareness and prevent death and injury on Territory roads. Road Safety is everyone's responsibility!

The competition aims to:

- Promote, encourage and stimulate the development of road safety messages that target our regional and remote areas;
- Share innovative film messages that have been created and developed by the people themselves within our regional.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entrants must be residents of the Northern Territory. Residents outside of the NT will not be eligible for cash prizes, but your films will be showcased on the night;
- The submitted film must be made specifically for the Road Safety Short Film Competition;
- The 2017 Road Safety Short Film Competition must be the film's first public screening;
- Films are to be submitted by post or by internet upload by **21st May 2017**;
- A maximum of 4 finalists per film category will be selected by the judging panel;
- All films entered in the Road Safety Short Film Competition may be used by the Northern Territory Government in road safety related educational and promotional activities;

- The films may also be utilised in whole or part to promote the Road Safety Short Film Competition;
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into;
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse to accept any entry:
 - (a) that contains any material which is or is reasonably likely to be defamatory, obscene, offensive, contrary to standards of decency;
 - (b) that has been submitted in bad faith; or
 - (c) which the organisers have reasonable grounds to believe infringes the intellectual property rights (including the moral rights) of a third party.

THE FILM

- The finished films are to be of a maximum **4 minutes** in duration (including titles and credits).
- Films must be submitted as a Quicktime file, either on a disc or USB memory stick. If your film is not in this format, please contact the competition organisers to discuss.
- All films must deliver a NT Department of Transport Road Safety message, visit www.roadsafety.nt.gov.au for more information.

Key messages include:

- Always wear your seat belts
 - Never drink or take drugs and drive
 - Licenced drivers are safe drivers
 - Don't ride in the back of utes
 - Don't put too many people in the car.
- All films are to be PG rated, suitable for viewing by children.

CLOSING DATE

The closing date for the competition entries will be **21st May 2017**. All entries must be submitted by this date.

JUDGING

- The films will be judged by a panel of film industry and Road Safety professionals;
- The following criteria will be considered in judging all Entries:
 - creativity
 - cinematography

- script/storyline
- effectiveness in conveying the road safety message
- Awards and prizes will be presented during the final concert at the 2017 Barunga Festival, Sunday 11th June;
- Finalists will be notified by **early June 2017** and are encouraged to attend the 2017 Barunga Festival.

Additional non monetary prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the Judging panel.

SCREENINGS

- The finalist's films are to be screened on the big stage at the Barunga Festival Friday 9th June 2017;
- Finalist films will also to be screened as a showcase of Road Safety Films available to other community festivals.

PARTICIPATION, POSTPONEMENT, VARIATION, CANCELLATION AND WITHDRAWAL

- The organisers may, at their discretion and without prejudice to any other rights, cancel, terminate, postpone, modify or suspend the Competition. This includes the right to cancel the Competition if fewer than 5 entries are received by the Closing Date.
- If the organisers cancel or postpones the Competition, or part thereof:
 - (a) it shall not be required to conduct the Competition at any other time; and
 - (b) it shall not be liable to any person for any loss or damage arising out of, or in connection with, the cancellation or postponement of the Competition (including, without limitation liability for

negligence); and

(c) it will not be required to award the prize to any Entrant.

- If at any time any circumstance or event beyond the organisers control occurs that affects the conduct of the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions, the organisers may take such action as it considers appropriate, including disqualifying any Entrant, cancelling, postponing, suspending or varying the Competition.

LOSS OF ELIGIBILITY

If the organisers become aware after the prizes have been awarded that the winning Entry does not meet the competition terms and conditions, then the Entrant:

(a) has no entitlement, right or interest in the prize; and

(b) will be required, at the discretion of organisers, to return, refund or otherwise make restitution of the prize.

LIABILITY

The organisers, including its employees, agents and contractors, are not liable for any injury, loss or damage to any entrant including any injury, loss or damage to any entry, resulting from directly or indirectly, their participation in the competition.

Information about having visual and/or audio recordings taken of you for the NT Government

Before you agree to have any recordings taken of or including you for the Northern Territory Government, there are some important things you need to know.

Note: Where photo or photograph is used, the same applies to any other recordings, such as video, film and sound.

What will happen to my photograph once it is taken?

The Northern Territory Government will store your photograph digitally in its photographic database and library. The talent release form that you signed will be placed in a file. The photograph and the form will be cross referenced to ensure we have your permission to use your photograph.

Who can use my photograph?

Once stored in the database, your photograph may be used by any Northern Territory Government department or agency.

Your photograph cannot be shared with any person, organisation or company outside of the Northern Territory Government without your express permission. This includes private companies, political parties, advertising agencies and charitable organisations.

Where will my photograph be used?

Your photo may be used in a variety of applications, ranging from small newsletters to major displays, websites and social media accounts. Some of the typical places you might see your photo include:

- In newsletters distributed in the Territory and interstate in both printed and electronic format.
- In advertisements in newspapers, magazines or television in the Northern Territory and the rest of Australia.
- In a range of printed publications such as government strategy documents or brochures promoting or explaining government services.
- On government websites and social media accounts.
- On government displays.

What if I don't want my photograph to be used somewhere?

It can be quite a surprise to see your photograph blown up two metres tall at a display, or to suddenly find yourself appearing on television. You need to be aware that your photograph may be used in these situations unless you ask for it not to be. If there are circumstances where you do not want your photo used, make sure you write that down on the Talent Release Form you sign. Or if you are giving permission for your photograph only to be used for one purpose, you also need to write this down.

I had my photograph taken some time ago and I no longer want it used. How can I get it taken out of the

database?

You should telephone the number on this form to discuss this.

Why do you need to know if I am Indigenous?

We appreciate that if you are Indigenous, there may be certain cultural sensitivities about using your image.

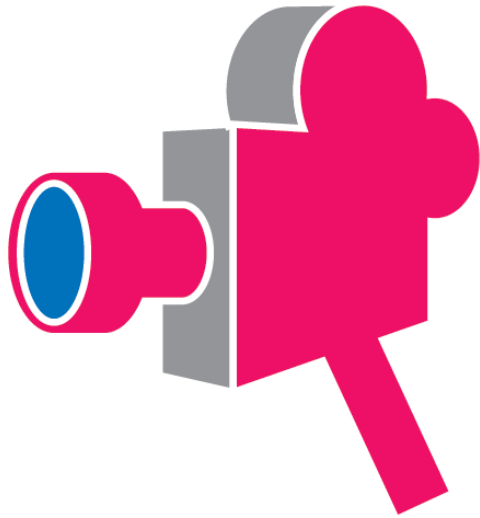
