- Prices quoted are in Australian Dollars (AUD) and are subject to 10% Goods and Services Tax (GST)
- All retail stalls are subject to acceptance by the Bagala Aboriginal Corporation (BAC) and/or the event coordinator.
- Third party agreements will not be entered into.
- Festival entry tickets allocated to stall holders are limited to the number aligned to the booking. Any additional ticketing requirements are to be purchased via the online ticketing portal.
- Please note: any power leads must be tested and tagged before accessing power at the festival.
- If your application is accepted, an invoice will be issued to the nominated business name from Bagala Aboriginal Corporation with payment due by the invoice due date.
- Cancellation by the stall holder: a full refund will be payable if the event organisers are advised in writing 30 days or more prior to June 5th 2026.
- It is the stall holder's responsibility to ensure their stall and belongings are secure for the duration of the event. Whilst a security team will be on site during the festival, no responsibility will be taken by the event organiser for loss or injury of any goods or persons.
- Please note: Barunga Festival is a drug and alcohol free event.
- A risk and safety brief will be provided to stall holders at the commencement of the event.
- 'Bump in' for the event is required prior to 12 noon (midday) Friday 5th of June. The event organisers will provide further direction closer to the event.
